**Provisions of Permit:**

1. The preserve must contain at least 160 acres, and shall be no more than 1,600 acres if the land is leased by the licensee, or 4,000 acres if owned by the licensee. The land does not need to be contiguous. The land shall be suitable upland bird habitat. The land shall not encompass any public land or limit any existing access to any public land (see Idaho Code 36:22.03 for grandfather exemption).
2. Boundaries must be posted every 150 feet if not fenced and every 500 if fenced.
3. Only artificially propagated upland game birds may be hunted; at least 200 of each species permitted must be released each season. Only those species of upland game birds approved by the Director or his designee as specified on the shooting preserve permit may be released. Candidate species for release include; pheasants, gray partridge, chukar, French red-legged partridge, quail (bobwhite, California valley, mountain, and gambel), and grouse (spruce, ruffed, blue, sage, and sharp-tailed).
4. Released birds must be banded, toe-clipped, or marked by a nasal scar (a permanent deformity caused by a blinder or device that partially obstructs the bird's vision). All released birds must be certified as disease free under standards set forth by the National Poultry Improvement Program.
5. Wild birds taken accidentally must be marked with a band purchased from the Department of Fish and Game.

6. Persons hunting on the preserve must have a valid Idaho hunting license or license to hunt upland game birds on a licensed shooting preserve only.
7. No more than 85% of the total number of each classified game bird species released may be taken. One hundred percent of other exotic species may be taken.
8. A registration book must be maintained listing the names, addresses, hunting license numbers, dates hunted and game taken by sex and species for each hunter.
9. Accurate records of total numbers, by sex and species, of game received and the date and numbers released must be maintained.
10. All rearing and holding facilities must be inspected and approved by the Director.
11. The Director or his designee shall be allowed reasonable access to the Preserve to inspect records and hunter bags.
12. The applicant is encouraged to submit a statement from the appropriate local planning authorities concerning the preserve's compliance with the local comprehensive land use plan and other applicable land use laws. The shooting preserve should be adaptable to use as a game breeding and/or controlled shooting area.
13. Permits are valid July 1 through June 30 (fiscal year).
14. Violation of any of the provisions relating to the regulation of shooting preserves shall be grounds for revocation of this permit.
