

Current and Proposed Pricing for 2016 Fish & Game Licenses, Tags & Permits



The proposal reflects an overall price increase of about 20% for resident licenses, tags and permits, which -- **with the *Price Lock*** -- is estimated to generate an additional 2.2 million dollars annually.

With *Price Lock*, license buyers can lock in at current 2015 prices and avoid proposed increased fees. Simply buy your license every year.
