

**Idaho Fish and Game Commission
Special Meeting
June 6, 2011
Boise, Idaho**

Present in the Director's Office: Sharon Kiefer, Deputy Director; Mary Boyer, Executive Assistant; Peter Hassemer, Anadromous Fish Manager; and Sam Sharr, Fisheries Anadromous Coordinator.

A special meeting of the Idaho Fish and Game Commission was held by telephone conference. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Wayne Wright with Commissioners McDermott, Trevey, Barowsky, Budge, Wheeler and Power participating.

RULES

Chinook Salmon Fishery

Pete Hassemer presented the Department proposal (Appendix 44, Exhibit 62) for a 2011 chinook salmon fishery in the upper salmon river – Stanley area. The proposal is for two jack Chinook salmon and six in possession; no adult salmon may be harvested.

11-56 Commissioner Power moved and Commissioner Barowsky seconded a motion to accept the staff recommendation for a jack Chinook season in the upper Salmon River Stanley area. The motion carried in a unanimous vote.

Amend the bag and possession limits for the 2011 spring Chinook salmon fisheries in the Clearwater River

Mr. Hassemer presented the proposal to the Commission (Appendix 44, Exhibit 63). The proposal is to increase the daily bag limit to six Chinook salmon, only two may be adults, and 18 in possession, only six may be adults.

11-57 Commissioner Trevey moved and Commissioner Power seconded a motion to implement the staff recommendation to increase the bag limit to two adult Chinook salmon on the Clearwater river. The motion carried in a unanimous vote.
