**LEGISLATION**

Deputy Director Sharon Kiefer presented a legislative update (Appendix 48, Exhibit 17) to the Commission.

**Fish and Game Sponsored Bill Analysis/Discussion/Action for Policy Position**

**House Bill 32** - Amends existing law to revise fee provisions and to provide for certain fees. The bill is held at the call of the Chairman at the Department's request.

**Senate Bill 1020** has passed in the Senate and was sent to the HRC for a hearing.

**New Bill Analysis/Discussion/Action for Policy Position**

RS23619 (replaces HB103) New bill number is **House Bill 161**

House Bill 103 Amends existing law to reclassify certain violations as infractions and to provide for penalties. The department will testify next week addressing technical correction.

**House Joint Memorial 5**

BOULDER-WHITE CLOUDS MONUMENT - Stating findings of the Legislature and opposing any national monument designation in the Boulder-White Clouds area of Central Idaho and declaring that any efforts to reach decisions regarding lands of Idaho administered by federal agencies be made by local collaboration, rather than by unilateral administrative processes that exclude the residents of Idaho.

The Department will continue to monitor and work with Representative Simpson staff to address concerns with the language of the bill.
