Boise, Idaho**

A special meeting of the Idaho Fish and Game Commission was held by telephone conference. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Mark Doerr with Commissioners Brad Corkill, Lane Clezie and Fred Trevey participating. Commissioners Blake Fischer, Kenny Anderson and Will Naillon were absent.

RULES

Season Setting: Open a Boise River Chinook Salmon Fishery

Sam Sharr, Fishery Anadromous Coordinator, presented the following proposal.

**2015 CHINOOK SALMON FISHERY PROPOSAL FOR
THE BOISE RIVER**

I. SEASONS – CHINOOK SALMON

- A. Opening Date:** The Boise River, from its mouth upstream to Barber Dam, opens to fishing for Chinook salmon on June 18, 2015.
- B. CLOSING DATE:** The Boise River closes to Chinook salmon fishing on September 30, 2015.

II. FISHING HOURS

- A.** Fishing for Chinook salmon is permitted 24 hours per day.

III. LIMITS

- A. Bag and Possession limits for the Boise River are:**
 - 1. **Bag (Daily):** Two (2) Chinook salmon, regardless of size.
 - 2. **Possession:** Six (6) Chinook salmon, regardless of size.
- B. Season, statewide:** No person may take more than twenty (20) adult Chinook salmon statewide during 2015 salmon seasons occurring prior to September 1, 2015. (Set through March Commission Action)

15-35 Commissioner Trevey moved and Commissioner Corkill seconded a motion to approve the 2015 chinook salmon fishery for the Boise River. All Commissioners voted in favor.
