Name of Volunteer Opportunity: Harriman State Park Fencing Update

Agency: Henry's Fork Foundation + Harriman State Park

Dates/seasons: June 28th – 30th

Meeting Location: Bing Lempke Parking Area (North Gate or “Logjam” parking lot) at 8:30 am

Time Commitment: 8:30 am – 4:30 pm on June 28th, 29th, and/or 30th (please let Jamie know your availability when you reply)

Description: This winter, the Henry's Fork Foundation (HFF), Harriman State Park, and local permittees partnered together to discuss fencing and the fall grazing season. This partnership has led to a fencing project, scheduled for June 28-30, to replace the entire fence on the east side of the river from the Logjam/Bing Lempke Parking Area to Osborne Bridge. Supplies have been acquired and will be staged prior to the project date. HFF is seeking volunteers to help in this effort to build and put up fencing. Please bring work gloves if you have them and wear durable clothing that you don't mind getting dirty. Lunch will be provided.

Thank you in advance for your willingness to help with this stewardship project. Building improved riparian fencing along the banks of the Henry's Fork in Harriman State Park will serve to both protect the river from degradation and provide opportunities to explore wildlife-friendly fencing sections.
