Name of Volunteer Opportunity: Host/Hostess at the Johnny Sack Cabin

Agency: USDA Forest Service

Dates/seasons: Starting June 13th Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays (One person per shift)

Also July 20, 25, 26, 27 are open—two volunteers for each shift as Jeannine Lee will be gone.

Also July 7, 21 & 28. Days Tamara Cikaitoga will be gone, so opportunity for 2 on each shift on all of those days.

An interactive calendar will be available on the Vol Op page showing the open dates and times.

Time Commitment: They will need **one person per shift** for either of 2 shifts on each Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday. The shifts are from 10-1 or 1-4.

Description: You will be working with Jeannine Lee, the Forest Service volunteer in charge of the cabin on those days. There may be additional dates and times which will become available.

Additional training provided? On the job training with Jeannine. You will be answering questions and providing information for visitors. You may be asked to open up the cabin or to close it. You will help with counting money at the end of the day and with general housekeeping chores such as sweeping, dusting etc. as needed. You will be given the code to the lock box which contains the key to the cabin.
